

### RACE CALLER Greg Miles



Greg Miles, the iconic Australian race caller, began his career in August 1978, calling races at Yering near Yarra Glen and debuting on radio in Canberra. In the late '70s and early '80s, he showcased his versatility by regularly calling Monday night greyhound races in Wangaratta. His pivotal moment came in December 1979 when he called his first race for ABC.

In June 1981, Greg replaced the legendary Joe Brown as ABC's race caller, solidifying his prominence in Australian horse racing. He then took over as the course caller at Caulfield and Sandown during Easter 1988 and Flemington in mid-1989.

After leaving ABC in 1998 to join Sky Channel, he briefly faced unemployment in May 2005 when Sky Channel lost race rights. However, he made a remarkable comeback as the chief caller at Radio Sport927 in June 2005.

In 2014, Racing Victoria entrusted him with the role of chief caller, and he went on to achieve a notable record, calling 36 consecutive Melbourne Cup Carnivals. His remarkable career culminated with an OAM award in 2016 and his retirement announcement in November 2016.

Throughout his career, Greg had the privilege of calling some of the greatest horses in racing history, including Winx, Black Caviar, Makybe Diva, Kingston Town, and Manikato.

Greg Miles will always be known for his unwavering passion and remarkable contributions to Australian horse racing, leaving an indelible mark on the sport.

He is a dedicated professional and a devoted family man, married to Alison with three children: Daniel, Nicole, and Jonathon.

The Kangaroo Island Racing Club Calcutta Sweepstake operates on the Dudley Wines Kangaroo Island Cup, to be run on 17 February 2024.

### **HOW IT WORKS**

Proceeds from the sale of tickets (less administrative expenses) are placed in the Calcutta Pool.

10 winning tickets are then drawn (subject to number of horses entered in the Cup), and each ticket then draws a runner in the Dudley Wines Kangaroo Island Cup. Each ticket is then offered for sale to the public by auction. Holders of a winning ticket receive half the winning bid of their ticket (horse). The other half of each winning bid is placed in the Calcutta Pool.

Successful auction bidders receive dividends from the Calcutta Pool, when the results of the Dudley Wines Kangaroo Island Cup are known. First 70%, second 20%, third 10%.

### Celebrating

### 140+ YEARS Racing on Kangaroo Island

Racing on KI began shortly after the Island was settled, with initial gatherings on beaches in an informal picnic style. The first official meeting with the SA Jockey Club took place at the Cygnet River race course in March 1883, where 'Lolo' won the 1883 Kangaroo Island Cup, owned by Mr. Richard Chapman and ridden by J. Melville.

Challenges such as world wars and economic downturns occasionally hindered racing on KI, but dedicated volunteers have ensured the club's prosperity. Despite its growth, the club maintains a casual atmosphere, offering a unique country racing experience.

In recent years, the club faced bushfires and Covid regulations, yet still managed to raise substantial funds for the Royal Flying Doctor Service and the KI Mayoral Bushfire Fund. During the fires, the club's on-course stables sheltered affected horses and provided a base for the Australian Army's firefighting efforts.

The club received accolades, including "The Greatest Achievement by a South Australian Racing Club" in 2019/2020 and "Event of the Year" by the Kangaroo Island Council in 2020/2021. Committee member Kerry Brinkley was awarded Volunteer of the year at Racing SA Awards in 2021 for his work in building 40 new overnight stables

With the Daw family's support, the club established the Arthur Daw Memorial Trainers Challenge worth \$10,000, and the Stanborough Family contributed the Austin Stanborough Jockeys Challenge, valued at \$2,000, increasing total prize money to over \$220,000.

Today, the club hosts three meetings annually, including the January Non-Tab meeting, a prelude to the two-day TAB Cup Carnival broadcast nationwide.
